CHICAGO, IL - Ogden & Fry, conducted a three-question poll June 20th – June 24th, statewide with 825 respondents. Respondents were selected by random sampling of likely 2020 General Election voters. The margin of error for this poll is +/- 3.48% at the 95% confidence interval.
