



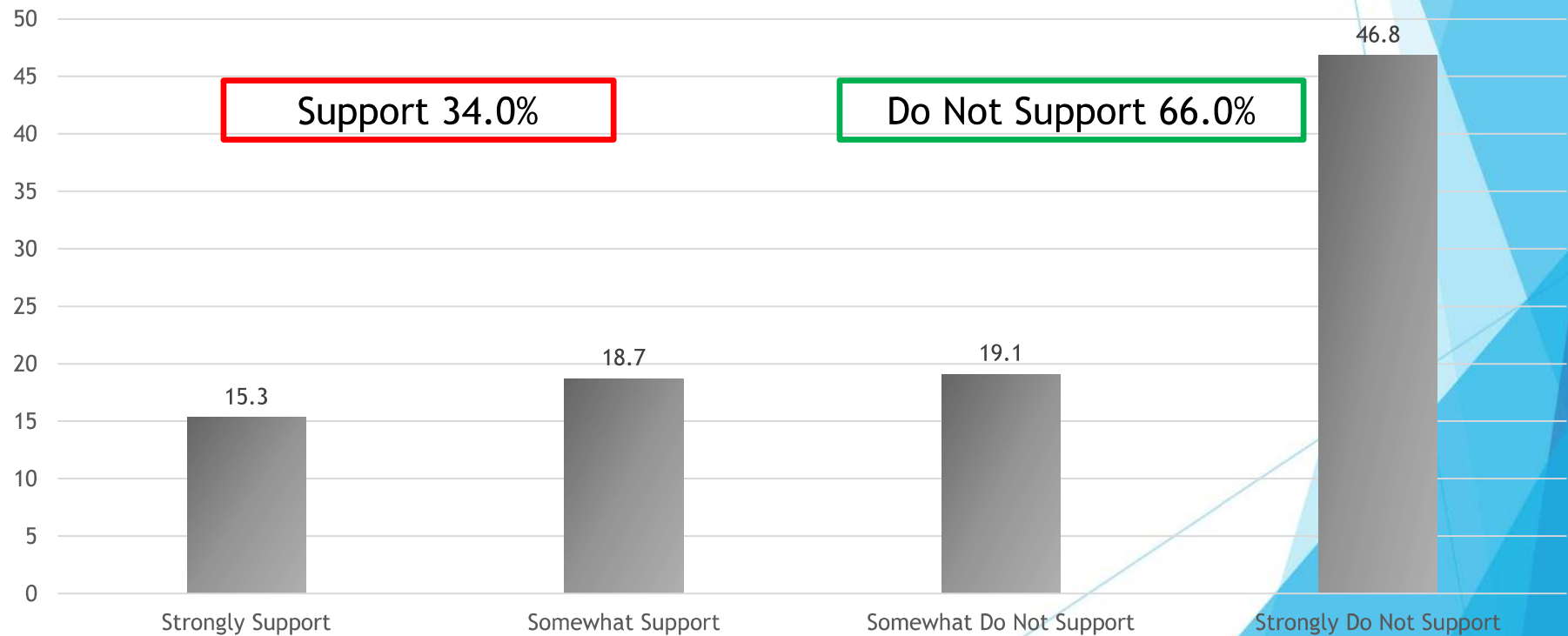

Criminal Justice Reform

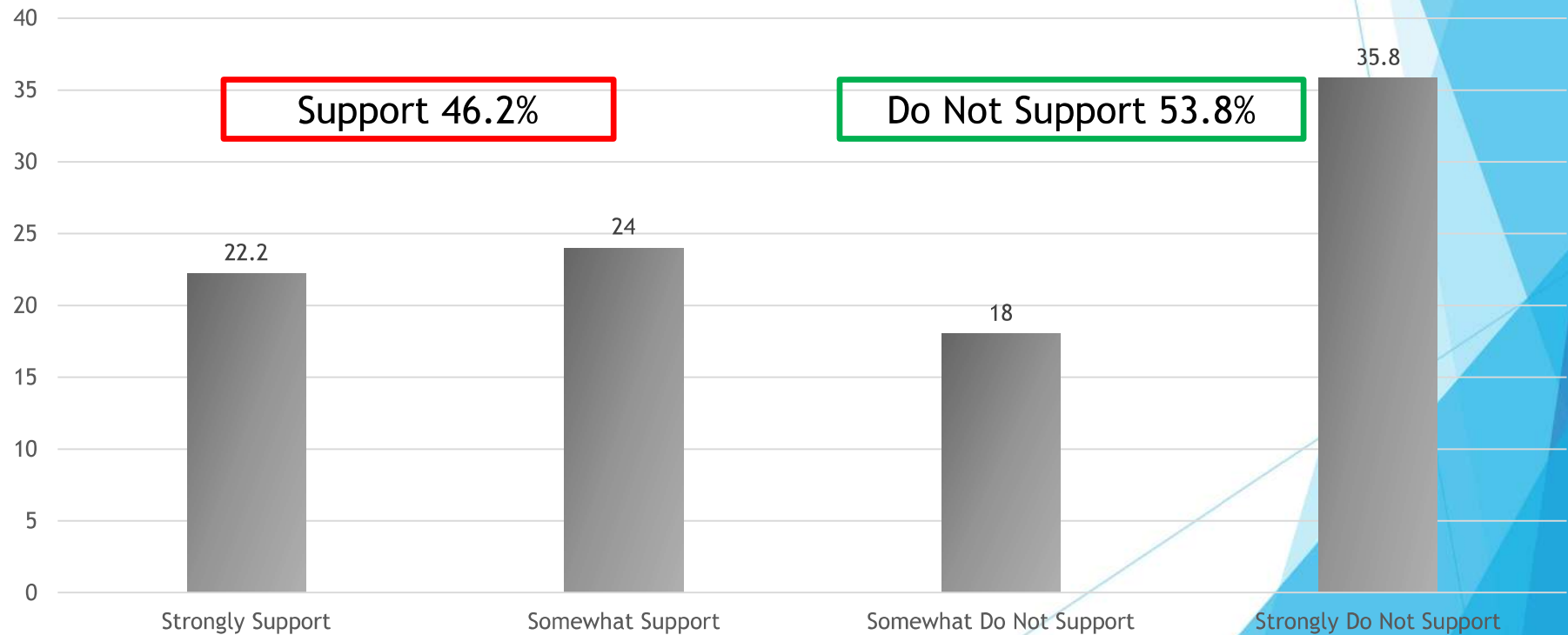
There is currently a bill on Governor Pritzker's desk awaiting signature that would enable an anonymous complaint to be made against a police officer that could result in the police officer being terminated. Criminal Justice Reform

There is currently a bill on Governor Pritzker's desk awaiting signature that would end cash bail and allow defendants to be released while awaiting trial. Cash bail is used as a guarantee that a defendant will return for a trial or hearings. The money is returned after the defendant makes all necessary court appearances, otherwise the bail is forfeited to the government. Do you support getting rid of cash bail?





Criminal Justice Reform

There is currently a bill on Governor Pritzker's desk awaiting signature that would enable a police officer to be charged with a class 3 felony if their body camera is not turned on. A class 3 felony generally carries a potential prison sentence of between 2 and 5 years or an extended term between 5 and 10 years. Do you support charging police officers with a class 3 felony for not turning on their body cameras?
